Policies for a Safe Reopening

PLEASE TAKE NOTE- NEW CLASS PROCEDURES

- Class sizes have been adjusted for better social distancing.
- · Mask/Face Covering must be worn at all times.
- Use hand sanitizer when entering/exiting studios and restrooms.
- Dancers will stay 6 feet apart while dancing on designated spots on studio floor.
- Clearly label all of your belongings with first and last name.
- Arrive at SBS dressed and ready to dance. There is no changing of clothes allowed anywhere in the facility. Please use the restroom before you leave to come to class.
- If you arrive prior to class time, please wait in your car to avoid crowds and long lines.
- Class start times will be staggered to allow time for social distancing, sanitizing and less traffic in common areas.
- Only one dancer may use the restroom at a time.
- Dancers must wash or sanitize their hands after every change of shoes.
- Class formats will be modified to remove any activity that would require contact between students.
 There will be no physical contact between teachers, staff or students unless necessary.
- Lobby and common areas will be monitored by staff to ensure social distancing during class transitions and exits.
- The "lost and found" has been removed. Anything left at the studio at the end of the night will be thrown away.
- Dancers who have a break between classes must leave the building during break.
- Plexiglass dividers have been installed at the front desk to promote social distancing.
- SBS will continue to follow all government and CDC guidelines, therefore, policies may change over time as new guidance is released. Any changes made will be communicated via email.
- Any dancer who cannot follow the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the building.

STAY AT HOME IF ...

- Anyone that does not feel comfortable with sending their dancer to the studio for any reason.
- Anyone with a dancer or family member that feels ill or has a fever.
- Anyone living or interacting with elderly people on a regular basis.
- Anyone that has been exposed to someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

We are still offering classes virtually!

HEALTH SCREENING

- Parents are expected to screen their own dancers for COVID-19 or other transmissible disease symptoms.
 Anyone with a cough, difficulty breathing, head lice or fever greater
- Anyone with a cough, difficulty breathing, head lice or fever greater than 100. should NOT come to class.
- Anyone who has been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days will not be allowed in the building.
- Attendance will be taken in every class to facilitate contact tracing.
- Make up classes must be scheduled with the front desk in advance
 of make up class to facilitate contact tracing, In-person make up
 classes may be unavailable due to social distancing requirements
 and room capacities.
- No drop in or single classes due to social distancing and contact tracing
- If you have traveled outside of NJ to any of the COVID-19 "hotspots," it is highly recommended that you self quarantine for 14 days.

SAFER STUDIO

Reopening Guidlines

DROP OFF + PICK UP

- Drop off your dancer at the front entrance of SBS. Follow the signs that read "Enter"
- Arrive at SBS dressed and ready to dance.
 There is no changing of clothes anywhere in the studio.
- If you arrive prior to class time, please wait in your car to avoid crowds and long lines.
- Lobby will be closed to parents and siblings.
- Anyone entering the studio must wear a mask/face covering.
- Parents/Guardians of students ages 6 and under are encouraged to wait in their cars in the parking lot in case their dancer has any separation or behavior issues.
- Classes may be dismissed up to 5 minutes early to allow time for additional social distancing and disinfecting time between classes.
- Pick up your dancer at the front entrance of SBS. Follow the signs that read "Exit."

CHECK IN + HEALTH SAFETY

- Temperatures will be taken for everyone who enters the studio. It will be taken at the door with a touchless thermometer.
- All staff and students must sanitize their hands upon entry into the building.
- Mask/face covering must be worn at all times. No one will be permitted into the building without a mask.
- All staff members will follow the same protocols.

PROTECTING OUR 5B5 FAMILY

- SBS Staff will be sanitizing all touch points between and during classes.
- Dancers may use a yoga mat for all floor stretches for additional protection.
- When using Acro mats, each dancer will be assigned their own individual mat for the duration of class. The mat will be disinfected before and after class. Dancers may place their yoga mat on top of the Acro mat for additional protection.
- Dancers may use a towel at the ballet barre as an added layer of protection.
- Markers have been placed throughout the lobby and dance rooms to ensure proper 6' social distancing.
- All bathrooms are now equipped with touchless soap dispensers and disposable toilet seat covers.
 - Restroom surfaces will be sanitized frequently throughout the night.
- Purifiers with True HEPA 13 filtration have been installed in each dance room to assist with air filtration.
- HVAC UV Purification Systems have been installed in each unit for disinfection.
- HVAC will be turned on in each space to assist with air circulation.
- Plexiglass shields have been installed at the front desk.
 - Entire facility will be thoroughly cleaned frequently.
